The American Black Film Festival (ABFF)

is an annual event dedicated to showcasing quality film and television content by and about people of African descent. It supports emerging artists to foster a wider range of images, stories and storytellers represented in the entertainment industry. The festival is committed to the belief that Black artists and content creators deserve the same opportunities as theirmainstream counterparts. ABFF founder Jeff Friday conceived the festival in 1997 as a vehicle to promote diversity in the motion picture industry, and strengthen the Black filmmaking community through resource sharing, education, artistic collaboration and career development. Today, the ABFF is recognized as the preeminent pipeline to new Black talent, both in front of and behind the camera, and is regarded as one of the leading film festivals in the world.

The ABFF is a property of ABFF Ventures, a multifaceted entertainment company specializing in the production of live events, television and digital content targeted to upscale African American audiences. ABFF Ventures, LLC. is a partnership between Film Life, Inc., and Black Enterprise.

M

uch has happened since we launched the American Black Film Festival 21 years ago. During those years, African American film professionals have experienced countless highs and lows, marked in turns by daunting barriers to diversity in the industry, as well as breakthroughs by auteurs of color who encourage and inspire us to redouble our commitment to the ABFF mission. We have never wavered from our conviction that, given the opportunity, black talent and creative content could be both universally appealing and commercially viable. This passionate belief, the driving force behind the festival from Day One, is now bearing fruit in the form of a true renaissance of African American talent in film and television.

The past 12 months has been a watershed year for black film creators, actors and other industry pros. Six black actors, including Viola Davis (who won Best Actress for her role in Fences) and her co-star and 2017 ABFF Honors recipient Denzel Washington earned Oscar recognition. African Americans also made history with Oscar nominations in other categories including producing, directing, cinematography and documentary. Moonlight, featuring supporting actor Oscar nominee Mahershala Ali, earned the award for Best Picture. Shows including Black-ish, Scandal and Power have changed the narrative of small-screen viewing.

This breakthrough year didn't just happen. As we often say in show business: It took two decades to bring about this "overnight" success. Over time, the ABFF has played a critical role in this evolution (or revolution) providing a platform for unique voices to project a range of images, stories, lifestyles and viewpoints. We have continued to demonstrate the undeniable fact that black people in America are not a monolith, but a population with an infinite variety of backgrounds, cultures, experiences and points of view.

What began as an untested format two decades ago with a mere 90 people in Acapulco, Mexico, is today America's largest gathering of black film and television enthusiasts and influencers, bringing together

more than 10,000 attendees annually. ABFF is now one of the nation's most powerful networking platforms, enabling legions of filmmakers to expand contacts, deepen relationships and conduct business with one another.

I have always been extremely proud of and thoroughly impressed with the trailblazers and luminaries who have graced our festival. But what has given me the greatest sense of exhilaration has been our discovery of and connection with industry disruptors who employ audacity, resilience and revolutionary ideas.

Today, these brilliant talents are reshaping the industry and our perception of what's possible. I celebrate and salute their achievements and eagerly anticipate the future, as the sowing of talent, nurtured by passion and opportunity, continues to bear amazing fruit.

ABFF will persist as a catalyst for the advancement of black independent filmmaking, and a wellspring of industry-wide excellence for generations to come.
